Dear Mr. Kempa:

Our law firm represents the Village of Sauk Village (the "Village"). Thank you for writing to the Village with your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.* Your FOIA request seeks documents related to 22401 Strassburg; police reports for the Speed family for the referenced address.

Your FOIA request is partially granted and partially denied as follows. The Village is releasing the attached records to you at no charge. All other information pertaining to your request is attached. The records contain information that is exempt from disclosure under the following exemptions in FOIA:

1. **7(1)(b):** Personal telephone numbers and home addresses (person not arrested). Section 7(1)(b) exempts from inspection and copying "private information, unless disclosure is required by another provision of [FOIA], a State or federal law or a court order." 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(b).
2. **7(1)(c):** Dates of birth, victims'/witnesses' names. 7(1)(c) exempts from inspection and copying "personal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless the disclosure is consented to by the individual subjects of the information." 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). The above-referenced information is highly personal, and the subjects' right to privacy with respect to this information outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining it.



3. **7(1)(a) Juvenile Court Act.** Section 7(1)(a) allows a public body to withhold "[i]nformation specifically prohibited from disclosure by federal or State law or rules and regulations implementing federal or State law," (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(a) (West 2010), as amended by Public Acts 97-333, effective August 12, 2011; 97-385, effective August 15, 2011; 97-452, effective August 19, 2011). The Juvenile Court Act mandates that reports in which a minor was arrested, charged or investigated must be withheld in full. See 2010 PAC 8941 (Ill. Att'y Gen. PAC Req. Rev. Ltr. 8941, issued October 22, 2010, at 2) and 2010 PAC 9077 (Ill. Att'y Gen. PAC Req. Rev. Ltr. 9077, issued February 9, 2011, at 2).
  
4. **7(1)(d)(iv):** Names of witnesses and other information that if disclosed would unavoidably disclose the identities of people who have filed complaints with law enforcement. Section 7(1)(d)(iv) exempts from inspection and copying records in the possession of law enforcement created for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that disclosure would "unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information" to law enforcement. 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(d)(iv).

You have the right to have the Village's denial of your FOIA request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General:

On 10/30/15 at about 0430 hours Ofc. Fredericksen #106 and I served search warrant #15SW7885 at 22401 Strassburg Ave.. We were assisted by the S.S.E.R.T. and other member of the Sauk Village Police Department. Suspect Shawanda Y. Speed, f/b, [REDACTED] was located at the residence. Speed is home owner of the target residence. There were two young children located inside the residence, they were identified as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Other residents were located inside the residence at the time of the warrant service. All subjects were transported to the Sauk Village P.D. for further investigation. Narcotics, narcotics packaging materials, and a firearm were all located in the target residence. Additional investigation in documented under related Cr #15-13841.

Ofc. Fredericksen and I met with Speed at 1003 hours. Speed was advised of her rights according to Miranda. Speed advised she understood he rights and agreed to answer questions regarding the investigation. Speed signed a Miranda waiver form. Speed denied selling drugs or owning a firearm. Speed knew about drug use at her residence but asked people to "get high" outside.

Based on the recovered items and case history, Speed was processed and charged with one count of Endangering the Life or Health of a Child under 720 ILCS 5/12C-5-A-1. Speed was given a court date of 12/21/15 at the Sixth District Courthouse. The children were released to Speed's sister, [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] D.C.F.S. was contacted. An investigation will be initiated reference intake #13108711.

In summary on 10-30-15 at approximately 0430 hours Inv. Grossman #117 and I, Ofc. Fredericksen #106, executed a search warrant refer #15SW7885 at 22401 Strassburg Ave with the aid of South Suburban Emergency Response Team (SSERT). After SSERT cleared the listed residence, Ofc.M.Spain #138 from Chicago Heights PD, a member of SSERT, advised he discovered a firearm in the living room located on the west wall. Ofc. Spain advised a male/black subject later identified as Ansil D. Speed was laying on top of the firearm which was located underneath the cushion of the couch. Ofc. Spain advised the firearm was not chambered, but had seven live .380 rounds in the magazine. Sauk Village Police transported all residents (Monjero D. Speed, Ansil D. Speed, [REDACTED]) inside 22401 Strassburg Ave to the PD for further investigation.

I then deployed K9 Falko and performed a search of the residence for contraband. First room Falko searched was the northside bedroom where our "target", Monjero D. Speed, was discovered. Falko alerted the presence of contraband by scratching on top of the bed located on the westside of the bedroom. After further investigating, I discovered two clear plastic bags containing multiple smaller clear plastic bags which contained a green leafy substance suspect cannabis. I also discovered in plain-view a small clear plastic bag containing multiple small clear empty bags (constant with distribution of contraband) located in the living room on top of a Television stand. Falko did not alert on anything further in the residence. Inv. Grossman discovered two pieces of indicia, which indicated that Monjero lives at 22401 Strassburg Ave.

Upon arrival to the Sauk Village PD, the green leafy substance field tested positive for approximately 30 grams of cannabis distributed into 55 small clear plastic bags. The firearm discovered was a .380 Black Cobra semi-automatic pistol with serial number of #FS076868 which contained seven live .380 rounds in the magazine. I read Monjero and Ansil their rights according to Miranda at 0853 hours which they waived their rights. Ansil advised the firearm was not his, but he has held it before. Ansil advised approximately four weeks ago, he moved it from the same located it was discovered the day of the search warrant (10-30-15) to another location due to children in the residence. Ansil believes the firearm belongs to his brother, Monjero, or a unknown female subject. Monjero advised he currently sells cannabis for United States Currency, but does not sell it inside the residence (22401 Strassburg Ave). Monjero advised he usually keeps the cannabis outside the residence, and sells in the driveway of 22401 Strassburg Ave. Due to the shooting incident which occurred on 10-22-15 refer to CR15-13952, he brought the cannabis inside 22401 Strassburg Ave in fear of losing his "product".

All evidence was logged and stored into the evidence vault as ex.1-6. ASA Nastoff approved one count of aggravated UUW by a felon for Ansil Speed. Monjero was charged with one count of unlawful delivery of cannabis and unlawful possession of paraphernalia. Both subjects will be transported to Markham for bond court at a later date and time. I have nothing further at this time.

ANSIL ADVISED HE WAS INVOLVED IN AN VERBAL ARGUMENT WITH [REDACTED] BECAUSE MONJERO OWES LASHONTA MONEY. AFTER THE TWO EXCHANGED WORDS, ANSIL GOT INTO HIS VEHICLE AND DROVE AWAY. ANSIL ADVISED HE WENT TO THE BANK AND GOT ICE CREAM. WHILE DRIVING BACK TO HIS RESIDENCE, HE OBSERVED [REDACTED] VEHICLE, WITH [REDACTED] IN THE DRIVER SEAT, DRIVING BEHIND HIM. ANSIL CLAIMS [REDACTED] TRIED TO "DRIVE HIM OFF THE ROAD". ANSIL ADVISED HE IMMEDIATELY WENT TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT. ANSIL ADVISED HE DOES NOT OWN A FIREARM AND DID NOT POINT A FIREARM AT [REDACTED]

On 03/12/2012 at 1756 hrs. I was dispatched to 22401 Strassburg Avenue in reference to a domestic issue being called in by a female caller. Upon my arrival I came to the rear of the property and found an Xbox power cord on the ground and the rear door to the residence also on the ground. The door appeared to have been dented and damaged as it was removed. I came into contact with the caller [REDACTED] who stated her son Monjero Speed was in a verbal argument with her to which he tore the rear door of the residence and threw it to the ground. She stated the two argued outside and he pushed her and then came into the residence and began breaking things. She stated he threw an MSI laptop onto the kitchen floor causing damage to it. I spoke to Monjero inside his bedroom to which he stated they were having a verbal argument and she threw the Xbox cord outside. He stated he then threw the laptop, but it was already damaged prior to him throwing it. He stated he removed the rear door because of how his mother was talking to him.

I observed the Xbox power cord outside and it did not appear damaged at this time. The rear door was damaged as it laid on the ground off the hinges. Ownership of the laptop computer which was damaged on the kitchen floor could not be verified at this time as both parties stated they owned it. [REDACTED] stated she would sign a complaint for criminal damage to property against her son Monjero for the damage done to the rear door. He was placed into custody at that time without incident and transported to SVPD to begin the booking process. [REDACTED] signed the complaint for CDP against Monjero. He was processed for one count of criminal damage to the rear door and will await transport to Markham County for a bond hearing. There is nothing further at this time.
