

Congratulations on the success of the Sauk Village Fire Department Fire Camp. Kudos to the great men and women from our Fire and Ambulance Departments as well as our dedicated Ladies Auxillary.



During the last week of July, the Sauk Village Fire Department hosted a Junior Fire Camp for children of all ages. The camp was held at the fire station July 24th through July 28, 2023 from 9am until 1pm. There were 15 kids total who attended the camp and experience various kinds of firefighting skills and equipment used by our everyday firefighters.

Monday's events were learning about two of the Sauk Village Fire Department's apparatuses, Squad 5110 and Truck 5120. The kids were split into companies correlating with the apparatuses and learned about the different tools and equipment located on these vehicles, as well as the breathing tanks and gear worn by firefighters. The activities were educational and fun, ranging from hose deployments and water spraying, Emergency Medical Service (EMS) utensils, to 911 dispatching and knowing how to call 911 and what information to provide.

The Sauk Village Fire Department would like to thank everyone for their support, the kids who made this experience worthwhile, and the parents who entrusted our members to educate their kids on multiple different aspects of our everyday lives.
