

VILLAGE ORDINANCES & REGULATIONS

For any community to be a safe, healthy, and pleasant place to live the Village government adopts various ordinances and regulations. The Village is asking everyone to cooperate in complying with these ordinances and regulations. The ordinances listed below are those that are most concerning to residents. The following does not cover all aspects of the Village's codes and ordinances. The complete set of codes and ordinances are located on the Village website at www.saukvillage.org.

Questions may be directed to the Municipal Center or the Police Department.

Parking:
☐ Parking is allowed on Village streets opposite the side where fire hydrants are
located. It is
unlawful to block or obstruct driveways or to allow a vehicle to block a sidewalk in
any way.
Parking is not permitted on any parkway or median strip in the Village or on grass, yards,
or other soft spaces.
□ When parking, be mindful of your neighbors' mailbox as the United States Post
Office will not deliver mail at a blocked box.
□ Contact the Police Chief if you are hosting a special event and require special
parking on both sides of the street for your guests.
☐ Special parking regulations are in effect in school areas: Please observe these
regulations:
☐ PARKING ON GARBAGE DAY: Parking is not permitted between the hours of 6:00
a.m. – 4:00 p.m. on scheduled garbage pickup day, or until after Republic Services has
passed through. Be sure to inform your guests of this regulation so that that are
ticketed.
☐ PARKING ON SAUK TRAIL OR TORRENCE AVENUE: There is no parking permitted
along Sauk Trail or Torrence Avenue.

Winter Parking:

Parking is not permitted at any time on any street after 2" of snowfall. Parking is not allowed until snow removal operations are completed.

There is no parking on a non-hard surface in the front, side, or rear of properties


