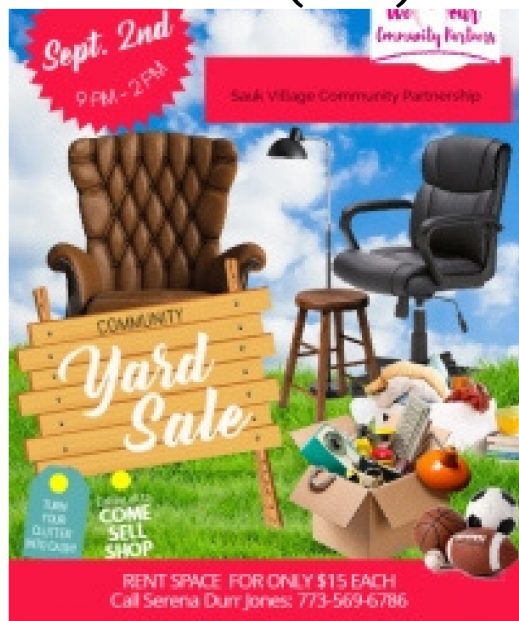

When an emergency occurs and you need to call 911, most people are unsure of what important information to give our dispatchers first. To ensure that you are providing important information, follow these three steps:

- Call 911
- Notify the dispatcher that you are in Sauk Village, IL
  - Request for a Sauk Village dispatcher

The File of Life is a program that believes everyone should receive the prompt, quality medical care they need, especially when it matters most – in an emergency. It gives first responders medical information when patients are unable to due to numerous reasons. The File of Life will include allergies, medications, contact persons, and many more important information. Patients can use the File of Life to keep together medical records and forms given from previous hospital visits as well.

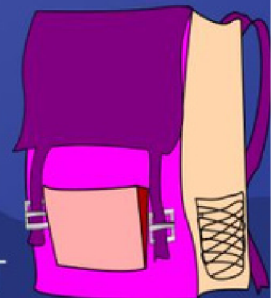
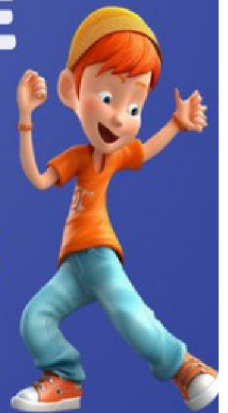
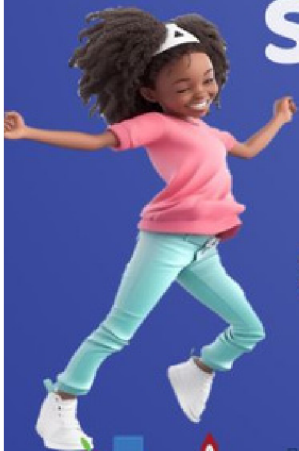
